Reporting directly to the Quality Manager, responsibilities include conducting detailed inspections, tests, and analyses of components to verify adherence to quality specifications and standards. **This is a day shift position, Monday through Friday 8am to 4:30pm.**

Roles & Responsibilities:

- **Quality Inspections:** Perform visual inspections and dimensional measurements of components to ensure compliance with quality specifications and standards, identifying any deviations or non-conformities and documenting them accurately.
- **Testing and Analysis:** Conduct various tests and analyses, such as hardness testing, tensile testing, and chemical analysis, to evaluate material properties and product performance, recording test results and observations meticulously.
- **Document Control:** Maintain detailed records of inspection and test results, ensuring that all documentation is complete, accurate, and easily accessible for review by the Quality Manager and other stakeholders.
- **Calibration and Maintenance:** Ensure that inspection and testing equipment is properly calibrated and maintained according to established procedures and schedules, performing routine maintenance and troubleshooting as needed.
- Quality Audits: Assist in conducting internal audits to assess compliance with quality
 management systems, procedures, and regulatory requirements, participating in audit
 activities and providing input as necessary.
